Officer in Charge

- 1. Arrange for the appliance to be sited correctly on the fireground
- 2. Establish communications with Comcen (6AR: Ch 51, 52, 55, 56, 57, 58 or 6IP: Ch 24, 25, 30, 80) Notify address of Control Point
- 3. Establish contact with Incident Controller (IC)
- 4. Establish and confirm fireground channels (Ch 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 96, 97, 98, 99)
- Air Operation channel from Ground Controller to Air Attack Supervisor / Bomber is Ch 23
- 6. Implement and apply ICS Battle Board
- 7. Set up communications plan
- 8. Complete Initial Management Plan
- 9. Complete Incident Action Plan
- 10. Complete Major Incident Management Plan
- 11. Complete High Rise Communications Plan
- 12. Assist Incident Controller and Operations Officer
- 13. Initiate Planning and Logistic Officer responsibilities until Incident Management
- 14. Team (IMT) is appointed
- 15. Forward all paperwork to IC at completion of Incident

Driver

- 1. Site appliance on fireground
- 2. Set up external power source
- 3. Set up canopy
- 4. Set up tables, chairs, whiteboards as required
- 5. Collect tee cards for ICS Battle Board and maintain
- 6. Operate Facsimile and Phone
- Using whiteboard establish map of fireground and establish locations of appliances
- 8. Hand out ICS Tabards
- Carry out duties as requested by OIC

Crew No 1

- 1. Help driver to set up power source and canopy
- Notify all appliances of fireground channel and maintain communications to sector commanders
- Log all communications on radio log
- 4. Carry out duties as requested by OIC

Crew No 2

- Operate fireground to Comcen channel
- Log all communications
- Carry out duties as requested by OIC
